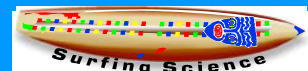
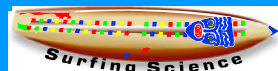

Promote Scientific Culture in a multicultural environment, allowing the sharing of experience and good practice so as to achieve higher-standard scientific activities.



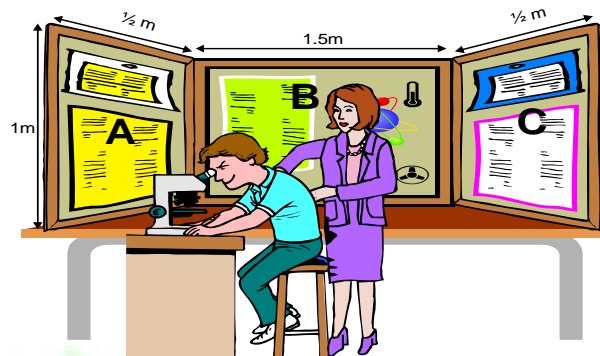

Exhibition Information



1. A poster board will be provided
(Size: A - Depth = 50cm, B Width = 150cm & C - Height = 100cm)
2. The length of your table will be 1.5m
3. Only prestik may be used on the poster board
4. No painting/spraying of the poster board is allowed
5. In order to accommodate all projects it is compulsory to use the backing board supplied by the organizers. Your displays must be sized to fit the backing board provided

Awards

- All participants will receive certificates and medals
- There will be special category awards

Expenses

- All members of each international delegation are responsible for the payment of their own air tickets and visa expenses
- All participants are responsible for their own pocket money
- Registration fee will be US \$300.00 per official participant and delegation leader (1 official adult for every 4 participants). The cost per additional visitors will be US\$ 600.00 to a maximum of 3 adults and 3 children. The registration fee covers all official meals, accommodation, transportation and activities from the 8th July to breakfast of 14th July 2006
- Special tours on Friday, 13 July will be at delegate's own expense
- **NB.** All delegates are responsible for all extra costs incurred in your room – phone calls, drinks from mini bar, pay-to-view movies on TV, room service, souvenirs, laundry, broken or missing equipment, lost keys, etc.

- School uniform or formal clothes (jacket and tie) at exhibition, Opening and Closing ceremonies
